ORDINANCE NO. 2015-226-0

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKFORD, ILLINOIS, THAT:


Chapter 105 of the City of Rockford Code of Ordinances, and the 2015 International Energy Conservation Code are hereby amended and modified, repealing and replacing any provision of ordinances, as attached hereto.

The provisions and sections of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable, and the invalidity of any portion of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of the remainder.

All orders, resolutions, or ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar as such conflict exists, and this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage, approval, and publication, as required by law.

A full, true and complete copy of this Ordinance shall be published within ten (10) days after passage in pamphlet form by and under authority of the Corporate Authorities.





Amendments to the Energy Conservation Code:

The ICC International Energy Conservation Code/2015 is amended as follows:

(1) Section 101.1 is amended as follows:

101.1 Title. These regulations shall be known as the *International Energy Conservation Code* of Rockford, State of Illinois, hereinafter referred to as “this code”.

(2) Section 101.2 is amended as follows:

101.2 Scope. This code applies to *residential* and *commercial buildings*. All buildings as defined by Section 101.4 shall comply with the State of Illinois Public Act 096-0778, **Energy Efficient Building Act**.

(3) Section 103.6 is added as follows:

103.6 Restriction of employees. An official or employee connected with the enforcement of this code, except whose only connection is that of a member of the board of appeals established under the provisions of section 113 of this code, shall not be engaged in, or directly or indirectly connected with, the furnishing of labor, materials or appliances for the construction, alteration or maintenance of a building, or the preparation of construction documents thereof, unless that person is the owner of the building; nor shall such officer or employee engage in any work that conflicts with official duties or with the interests of the department.

(4) Section 104.1 is amended as follows:

104.1 General. Construction or work for which a permit is required shall be subject to inspection by the *code official*. The *code official*, upon notification, may make the inspections set forth in Sections 104.2 through 104.9.

(5) Section 104.9 is added as follows:

104.9 Re-inspections. Any item of inspection that fails to meet code requirements on the initial or first re-inspection shall be subject to re-inspection fee as determined by the City of Rockford Code of Ordinance, charged to the permit holder for each additional re-inspection performed.

(6) Section 107.2 is deleted and replaced with:

107.2 Fee Schedule. The fees for work shall be as set forth in the Fee Schedule of the City of Rockford Code of Ordinances. No permit can be issued for any person, company or contractor until any outstanding permit fines/fees have been paid in full.

(7) Section 107.3 is deleted and replaced as follows:

107.3 Work commencing before permit issuance. When a permit is required by this code, and work is started or proceeded fees shall be in accordance with the City of Rockford Code of Ordinance. No permit can be issued for any person, company or contractor until any outstanding permit fines/fees have been paid in full.

(8) Section 107.5 is deleted and replaced as follows.

107.5 Refunds. No permit fees shall be refunded.

(9) Section 109.4 is added as follows:

109.4 Automatic appeals. In any case where orders or approvals by the Code Official and Director of the Fire Prevention Bureau are not in full agreement, the matter shall be resolved in the following manner: The case shall be reviewed by the Community Development Director and the Fire Chief. If agreement cannot be reached, the matter shall be referred to the

City Administrator for review and decision. The decision of the City Administrator may then be appealed to the Building Board of Appeals pursuant to Section 113.1.

(10) Section 108.4 is amended as follows:

108.4 Failure to comply. Any person who shall continue any work after having been served with a stop work order, except such work as that person is directed to perform to remove a violation or unsafe condition, shall be liable to a fine of not less than \$50.00 dollars or more than \$75.00 dollars.
