### NEW BUSINESS

#### Certificate of Appropriateness – 956 Ridgewood Road

Greg Rudeen reviewed his request to build a 3' x 5' closet addition to the north side of the house, not to extend beyond the front of the main structure. Mr. Rudeen stated the structure would connect to the existing bump-out to come flush to the front of the house. The roof line will be extended over the new structure. He explained the large pool in the back yard has been neglected but it is his intention to clean it up.

He also wishes to build a pergola over the driveway on the south side, which will not be attached to the house. It will be built of wood, painted the same as the color of the house and built to match a drawing that he submitted at the meeting.

A **MOTION** was made by David Hagney to **APPROVE** the request for a 3' x 5' addition to the north side of the house and to **APPROVE** a pergola over the driveway on the south side as per photo submitted. The Motion was **SECONDED** by Vickie Krueger and **CARRIED** by a vote of 4-0.

With no further business to come before the Commission, Vickie Krueger mad a **MOTION** to adjourn. The Motion was seconded by Janna Bailey and **CARRIED** by a vote of 4-0. the meeting was adjourned at 5:42.
