

TEMPORARY & PERMANENT SEEDING

Properly installed and maintained



Sites that will be inactive for more than 14 days must be temporarily stabilized by the 7th day. Once construction is completed the site must be restored.



Before you can terminate the permit you must have 70% uniform vegetative cover throughout the site. This site is at 50%.



This site has 70% uniform vegetative cover and the IEPA permit is eligible for termination.

Improper installation and lack of maintenance



The site was not stabilized after grading was completed. Therefore gullies were beginning to form.



The IEPA permit for this site cannot be terminated because it does not have 70% uniform vegetative cover.



This site was inactive for more than 14 days and was not seeded. Therefore rills began to form on the slopes.
