## Narrative

The Rockford Fire Department responded to 4121 Florida Dr. for a apartment fire. The fire was noticed by the crew of Engine 11 while responding to a medical call at a different address. Engine 11 reported the fire and went in to extinguish the fire. Several crews were needed to get the fire under control. The building is an 18 family apartment building. Fire damage was limited to one end of the building. Six of the apartments were damage directly by fire and water. Additional lower level apartments had some water damage. Red Cross assisted with relocating the occupants who were unable to return to their apartments. Due to the length of the incident the Salvation Army responded with their canteen with coffee for the crews and RMTD supplied a bus for occupants and firefighters to warm up in. One firefighter had minor injuries but was able to continue working. It is unclear at this time how many families were displaced. The cause is under investigation.
