Please make the following questions to the above mentioned bid package.

Questions:

The RFP/Addendum #2 state there are 711 centerline miles of road in the City. Can the City provide an estimate of lane-miles by functional class or in total? **Answer: The City will not be providing this information.**

1. Is the City willing to negotiate any contractual terms in the RFP? **Answer: Yes as far as scope and fee.**
2. Do you have a PMS software that you currently use? If so what software do you use? **Answer: Per addendum #2 the City does not have a preference to a specific software.**
3. Does this project include collecting imaging in all lanes including turn lanes? **Answer: Yes**
4. Do you require the data to be collected and processed as per ASTM D6433-18? **Answer: Per Addendum #2 the City does not have a preference to a specific methodology.**
5. **Does this Project require survey of 100% of images? Answer: Yes.**
6. Do you require that all distresses need to be identified and processed? **Answer: Yes.**
7. In what format is the City's existing pavement management data base? How were the PCI scores calculated? Were the scores calculated using PMS software or excel spreadsheet or manually assigned? **Answer: Per Addendum #2 the City uses ESRI products. The past report will not be made available for purposes of this addendum. Historical condition data will be made available to the selected consultant.**



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8. Do you have the breakdown of lane miles by surface type? **Answer: Approximately 5-10% of roads are concrete paved with the remaining being asphalt.**
9. For what percentage of the network are the actual traffic counts available? **Answer: The City will not be providing traffic count information as part of this addendum.**
10. Are the counts associated with each segment and made available for viewing in the City's GIS? **Answer: No.**
11. Does the City currently maintain accurate historic construction history information (last construction date) for each street segment? For any missing information will the City be able to provide? **Answer: The City can provide any available historic information to the successful consultant.**
12. Does the City currently maintain accurate street inventory information (length, Width, pavement type) for street segment in the City's GIS? Will the City provide a copy of the current GIS Centerline shapefile? **Answer Per Addendum #2 a shapefile will not be made available for purposes of this addendum. However, a shapefile will be supplied to the selected consultant.**
13. What is the required resolution of imaging data collected? **Answer: The City has no specific resolution requirement other than the images should be of a quality that can be easily viewed with standard means.**

All other portions remain unchanged.
